

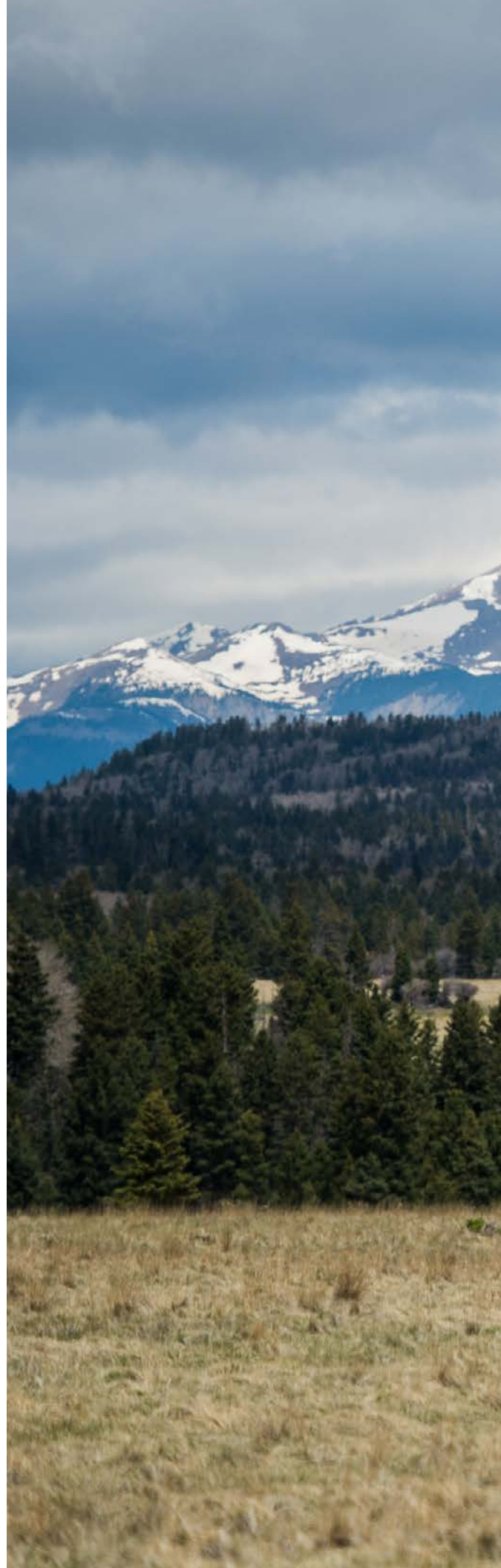

If you are flying in on a private plane, the closest FAO is the Raton, NM airport operated by Express Aviation Services. 
WELCOME

TROPHY HUNTS

The Express UU Bar ranch is known internationally for its trophy elk, which are some of the largest free ranging bull elk found anywhere.

Given the 180,000 acres of breathtaking native country and through the implementation of sound game management principles overseen by GM John Caid (former Chairman of the Board of the Rocky Mountain Elk Foundation and former Director of the White Mountain Apache Tribe's Game and Fish Department and their world famous trophy elk program for 30 years), the Express UU Bar hosts hunters from all over the world to enjoy some of North America's top trophy hunting of Elk, Mule Deer and Antelope. Hunters also enjoy generous populations of native Black Bear, Lion and Merriam Turkey.

Our typical Trophy Bull Elk Packages consist of a six-night, five-day all-inclusive packages. Five full days of hunting come with one-on-one guide services and are complemented by breathtaking back country, beautiful and luxurious accommodations and gourmet meals. Or, if you are looking for a more rustic experience, we offer high mountain cabins on a limited basis.

Packages include all required New Mexico private land licenses, tags and stamps (when applicable), professional guide services, lodging and meals, 24/7 access to the Rayado Lodge, on-site transportation, field dressing (and/or caping out your harvest to your specifications) and post-hunt photograph(s). We also include transportation to the local processor and local taxidermist.

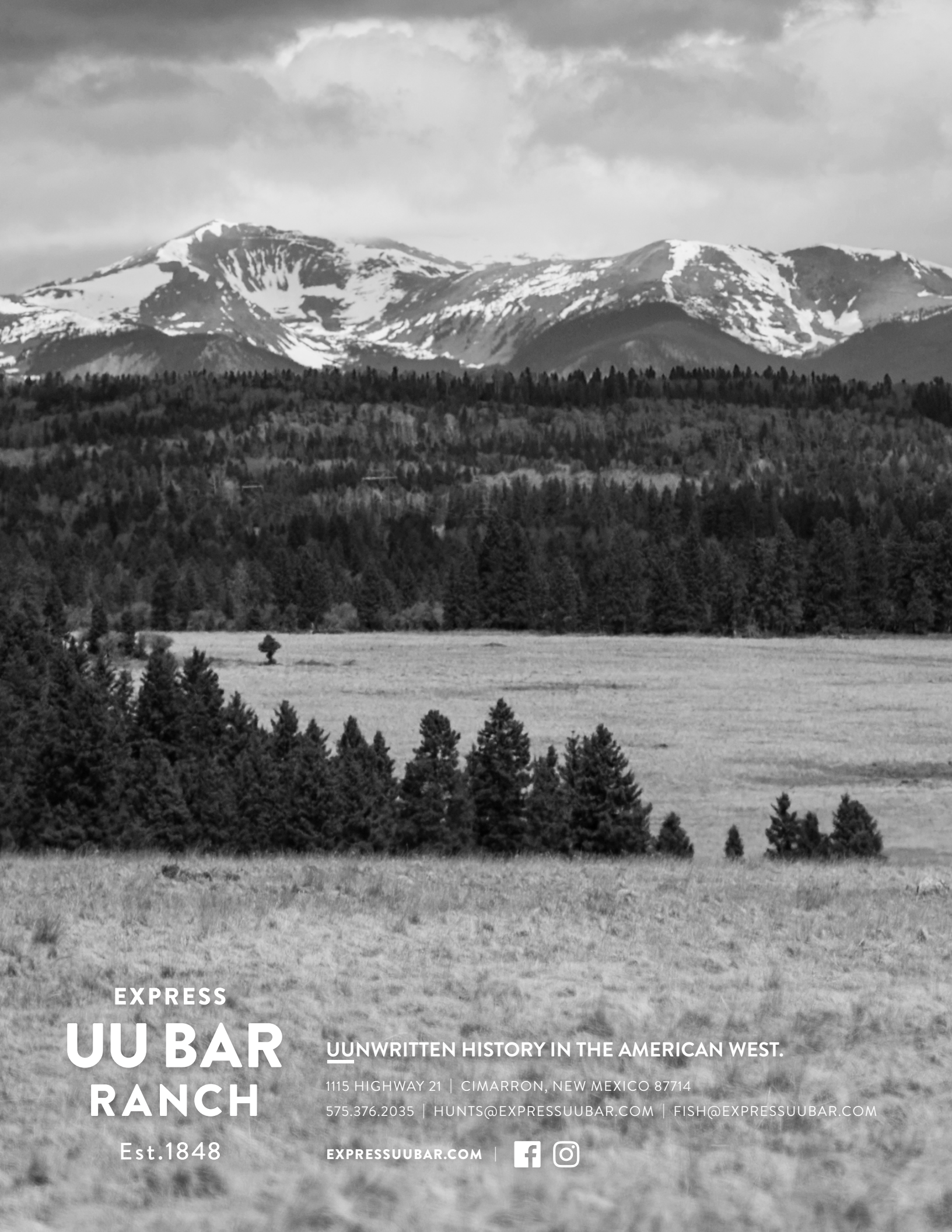
Bob's pursuit of being ranked #1 in another industry (Angus Purebred Seed Stock Operation) was realized in 2000 and continues each consecutive year. In
